Mi-Bémol Saxophone Ensemble was founded in 1989, when a group of dedicated professional saxophone players gathered together under the direction of Masahiro Maeda in pursuit of a new way to interpret the classic orchestral music. He created an ensemble of more than 20 saxophones, having been inspired by his saxophone study at the Conservatoire National de Lyon with Serge Bichon.

This unique ensemble consists of six types of saxophone: soprano, alto, tenor, baritone, bass saxophone and tubax. The ensemble performs a variety of music including classical,



pop and jazz. The vibrant and perfectly balanced sound of these 20-plus saxophonists create the reminiscence of an orchestra. The group has performed many concerts since its inception in Japan. These include Europe, Asia, and North America, including Carnegie Hall in New York City. The group has performed not only in major concert halls but also in venues such as churches, parks, and vineyards, creating a close connection with the audience. Mi-Bémol has released more than ten CDs. The ensemble's videos on YouTube have garnered much attention and glowing praises.
